

Thanksgiving Prayers

- Father, we thank You for bringing us into the year of rest and expansion. We thank You for the promises and the plans You have ordained for us in this year. We thank You in advance for the manifestation and fulfillment of every promise You have spoken concerning us.
 - **Psalm 100:4-5 NKJV** – ⁴Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, *And* into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. ⁵For the Lord *is* good; His mercy *is* everlasting, And His truth *endures* to all generations.
 - **Jeremiah 29:11 NKJV** – ¹¹For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
 - **Numbers 23:19 NKJV** – ¹⁹“God *is* not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?
 - **Philippians 1:6 NKJV** – ⁶being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete *it* until the day of Jesus Christ.

Grace for Consecration and Divine Preparation

- Father, grant us grace to consecrate ourselves fully—spirit, soul, and body—as vessels set apart for You. Prepare us inwardly and outwardly for all that You have ordained for us in this year.
 - **Joshua 3:5 NKJV** – ⁵And Joshua said to the people, “Sanctify^[c] yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you
 - **1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 NKJV** – ²³Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify^[g] you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴He who calls you *is* faithful, who also will do *it*.
 - **2 Timothy 2:20-21 NKJV** – ²⁰But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. ²¹Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, ^[h]sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.
 - **Romans 12:1 NKJV** – I beseech^[a] you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your ^[b]reasonable service.

- Lord, as we consecrate ourselves wholly to You, clothe each one of us with the divine knowledge, wisdom, and understanding we need to discern, enter, and walk in the fullness of all You have ordained and desire for us in this year.
 - **Daniel 9:22-23 NKJV** - ²²And he informed *me*, and talked with me, and said, “O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand. ²³At the beginning of your supplications the ^[d]command went out, and I have come to tell *you*, for you *are* greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision:
 - **Proverbs 2:6 NKJV** – ⁶For the Lord gives wisdom; From His mouth *come* knowledge and understanding.
 - **Colossians 1:9-10 NKJV** – ⁹For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; ¹⁰that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing *Him*, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.
 - **Ephesians 5:17 NKJV** – ¹⁷Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord *is*.

- Father, stretch us and enlarge our capacity to receive and steward the expansion You are releasing into our lives. Make room within us, strengthen our foundations, and establish us to fully possess and sustain all You have appointed for us in this season.
 - **Isaiah 54:2-3 NKJV** – ²“Enlarge the place of your tent, And let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords, And strengthen your stakes. ³For you shall expand to the right and to the left, And your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the desolate cities inhabited.
 - **Psalms 18:32-33 NKJV** – ³²*It is* God who arms me with strength, And makes my way perfect. ³³He makes my feet like the *feet of* deer, And sets me on my high places.
 - **Psalms 81:10 NKJV** – ¹⁰*I am* the Lord your God, Who brought you out of the land of Egypt; Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.

Prayers for the church

 - **Isaiah 40:29 NKJV** – ²⁹He gives power to the weak, And to *those who have* no might He increases strength.
 - **Psalms 27:14 NKJV** - ¹⁴Wait^[a] on the Lord; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the Lord!
 - **Ephesians 4:11-13 NKJV** – ¹¹And He Himself gave some to *be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, ¹²for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the ^[a]edifying of the body of Christ, ¹³till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ
 - **Daniel 10:18-19 NKJV** – ¹⁸Then again, *the one* having the likeness of a man touched me and strengthened me. ¹⁹And he said, “O man greatly beloved, fear not! Peace *be* to you; be strong, yes, be strong!
- We do not rush into expansion unprepared; we enter 2026 positioned, rooted, and authorized to fully possess, sustain, and multiply all that God has prepared for us.
 - **Jeremiah 17:7-8 NKJV** – ⁷“Blessed *is* the man who trusts in the Lord, And whose hope is the Lord. ⁸For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river, And will not ^[a]fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, And will not be anxious in the year of drought, Nor will cease from yielding fruit.
 - **2 Corinthians 9:8 NKJV** – ⁸And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work
